1 · Vocabulary

Word	Meaning	Example
song	A short piece of music with words.	<i>I love that song on the radio.</i>
instrument	A tool used to make music, like a guitar or piano.	<i>She wants to learn how to play a new instrument.</i>
concert	A live performance of music in front of an audience.	<i>We went to a concert last weekend.</i>
melody	A sequence of notes that is pleasant to hear.	<i>The melody of the tune is easy to remember.</i>
lyrics	The words of a song.	<i>The lyrics of this song are very simple.</i>
genre	A type or style of music, such as pop or rock.	<i>My favorite genre is pop music.</i>
band	A group of musicians who play together.	<i>The band played for an hour.</i>
rhythm	The pattern of beats in music.	<i>The rhythm makes you want to dance.</i>
