1 · Vocabulary

Word	Meaning	Example
platform	A website or app used for learning online	<i>I use an online platform to watch my math lessons.</i>
assignment	A task given by a teacher	<i>The teacher posted a new assignment on the portal.</i>
deadline	The latest time something can be submitted	<i>The deadline for the essay is Friday.</i>
interactive	Allowing active participation	<i>The interactive quiz helped me understand the topic better.</i>
distraction	Something that takes your attention away	<i>Social media can be a big distraction during online classes.</i>
feedback	Comments about your work	<i>I received helpful feedback on my presentation.</i>
flexibility	The ability to change or adapt easily	<i>Online learning offers flexibility in choosing study times.</i>
connectivity	The quality of the internet connection	<i>Poor connectivity made the video freeze.</i>
