- Use 'a' before a singular countable noun that begins with a consonant sound.
- Use 'an' before a singular countable noun that begins with a vowel sound.
- Use 'the' when both speaker and listener know which specific thing is meant.
- Use 'some' for positive statements about an unspecified amount of countable or uncountable nouns, and 'any' for questions or negatives.
