## 1 • Rules

- ◆ Add -er to short adjectives (e.g., tall → taller) to compare two things.
- ◆ Use more before longer adjectives (e.g., careful → more careful) for comparison.
- ◆ Place than after the comparative adjective to show what is being compared.
- ◆ For adjectives ending in -y, change y to i and add -er (e.g., happy → happier).

## 2 • Signal words

than more less rather comparatively

**Tip:** These words often flag **Comparative Adjectives** — spot them, then choose the form.
