1 · Rules

- Use 'this' and 'these' for things that are near the speaker.
- Use 'that' and 'those' for things that are far from the speaker.
- 'This' and 'that' are singular; 'these' and 'those' are plural.
- Demonstratives usually come before a noun.
- When the noun is already known, you can use a demonstrative to point it out.
