- ◆ Use 'be going to' + base verb to talk about plans or intentions.
- ◆ The verb 'be' must agree with the subject (am, is, are).
- ◆ 'Going to' is followed by the base form of the main verb.
- ◆ Use 'going to' for predictions based on present evidence.
