- ◆ A phrasal verb of movement combines a verb with a particle that indicates direction or location.
- ◆ The particle usually follows the verb directly and the meaning can be literal (e.g., “go out”) or idiomatic.
- ◆ When the object is a noun, it normally comes after the whole phrasal verb (e.g., “walk out the door”).
