### 1 · Rules

- ◆ Use will for definite future actions or predictions.
- ◆ Use would for hypothetical situations or polite requests.
- ◆ Would is the past form of will in reported speech.
- ◆ Would can also express willingness in conditional sentences.

### 2 · Signal words

will would if maybe in the future could perhaps

**Tip:** These words often flag **Will vs Would** — spot them, then choose the form.
