- ◆ Place the auxiliary verb (do/does/did, be, modal) at the beginning of the sentence.
- ◆ If the main verb is 'be', invert it with the subject (Is she...?).
- ◆ If a modal verb is used, put the modal before the subject (Can they...?).
- ◆ Keep the rest of the sentence unchanged after the subject.
- ◆ End the question with a question mark.
