- E** A leafy green vegetable used in salads.
- F** A red fruit often used in salads, technically a fruit.
- G** A long green vegetable often sliced for sandwiches.
- H** A long yellow fruit that is soft and sweet.
- I** A fuzzy orange fruit with a sweet juicy flesh.
- J** Small round purple or green fruit that grows in bunches.
- K** A round citrus fruit with a thick orange skin.
- L** A vegetable with layers that makes you cry when cutting.
